Edward Lorenzen, whose serious illness was related last week died Monday, September 27th in the Methodist hospital in Omaha. Mr. Lorenzen had been in poor health for over a year and in November of last year he and his family went to Phoenix, Arizona, to live, hoping that the climate would be of benefit to him. When his health did not improve they returned to Shelby county about six weeks ago. He later entered the Methodist hospital in Omaha where a delicate and serious operation for the removal of two lobes of the lung was performed.

He seemed to have stood the ordeal well and was showing improvement when he took a turn for the worse and passed away Monday morning at 10:30 o'clock.

Edward Lorenzen was the youngest son of Lorenz and Katie Lorenzen and was born in Shelby County, Iowa, three miles north of Irwin, April 7, 1901, being 36 years, 5 months and 20 days of age at the time of his death.
